

20 Years Ago in Pit Stop ~August 2002

On the cover was a picture of Doug Brians Corvette, an article about an August **ESCA** autocross at the Sonoma County Airport, an article about an **ESCA** Birthday tour, and an announcement about **ESCA**'s new web site.

In a Beard Speak column the Chairman talked about the 15 founding **ESCA** members, the autocross site, all the new members and the 35 members who had showed up at a July regular meeting.

A Welcome New Members list had 6 names, none of which are still members. A Discount notice stated Big "O" Tires was giving **ESCA** members a 10 % discount on labor.

An autocross article entitled "One Word; Finally!" by Jeffrey Carter, started off with the mix up at the airport gate where the security guard wanted the check for the days event. But things got cleared up and **ESCA** got to run at their brand new-old facility. (**ESCA** had run at the airport starting in 1977, but were asked to leave when the US Government came in to clean up the toxic site left from World War Two)

The results showed 54 drivers, with Frank Jurin taking Top Time of Day.

A small notice stated that if you wanted your Pit Stop as a PDF you could now get it that way just by letting the editor know.

There was also a list of 49 ESCA members e-mail addresses.

A calendar listed events Monterey Historics at Laguna Seca, Pebble Beach Concours, Wine Country Concours at SRJC, Sausalito Car Show, AAS Auto-X at Cal Expo, and SCCA Auto-X at Cal Expo.

The 2002 **ESCA** Board was listed as Chairman Bob Jenkins, Vice-Chairman Blain Hendrix, Secretary Linda Jurin, Treasurer Claudia Quinlivan, and Ex-Officio Jeff Engblom.

A membership list had 76 names of which 23 are still members.

GLOSSARY

BELL HELMET - A protective device worn during potentially hazardous events, such as autocross, hillclimbs and Board meetings. **FUNKHANA** – An autocross with gimmicks, which no one come to. **RAG TOP** - An accessory for open top cars designed to efficiently channel rainwater into the interior for driver cooling.

RALLYE – The technique of getting lost by carefully misinterpretation of a set of explicit instructions.

T & D RALLYE - Getting lost while maintaining a high average speed, i.e., going nowhere fast.

AUTOCROSS – A speed event secretly promoted by local tire dealers CONCOURS – An event secretly promoted detailers, restoration shops and wax companies.



A pair of rallies with an overnight stay at Twin Pine Casino and Hotel

This event is open to all rallyists, regardless of PCA membership or car driven. The Saturday rally will start in Napa and finish at Twin Pine Casino and Hotel. The Sunday rally will start at Twin Pine Casino and Hotel and will finish in Kenwood. Each rally is about 100 miles long and all roads are paved. Awards, three-deep, will be presented for each rally at the conclusion of the day.

No math is required; both rallies will use a modified Monte Carlo format. All checkpoint locations and times will be provided. There will be no traps or gimmicks; miles and diagrams will be given for all turns.

Harvest Moon

The Harvest Moon is the full Moon that occurs closest to the start of Autumn. Before electricity, farmers depended on the Moon's light to harvest their crops late into the night. In 2022, the Harvest Moon will occur on September 10th. That sounds like a good excuse to harvest some great Sonoma County back roads.

PCA membership is not required and all cars are welcome. A navigator is required and additional occupants are welcome.

All roads are paved and the route will be welldefined with miles to each turn and a diagram of the intersection. Minimum distances will be given and the checkpoints will be within sight of their minimum distances. The time you are due at the checkpoint will also be given so there will be no need to calculate arrival times. You will be using the Richta Competitor app on your smartphone, which includes the official rally time. Simply pass the checkpoint at your time.
