

My name is John Schliemann. Most club members know me, or know of me. **ESCA** wanted Board Members to write up a profile article about themselves so here it goes. I will do the best I can maybe you might learn something about me you did not know.

Born 1961, been in Sonoma County since 1977. Graduated Montgomery High School 1980



my first car was 1966 Plymouth Barracuda, after that came a Chevy Vegas and building a 1974 327 Chevy V8 Vega with the help of my Jr high school and college buddy Eric Siedentopf. I Have been doing autobody repairs 40 plus years. Have been at Western Auto Body 23 years. Over the years I have bought wrecked cars, repaired and sold them as a side job. Over the years with **ESCA** I have been Chairman 4 years, also Vice Chairman and ex-officio several times. Thanks to all of you I very much have enjoyed being involved in this club. I have two children, Tony who is now 37 years old and Christina at 33. I now find myself with six grandkids.

My son, Tony was in the club for a while before having kids. He started out autocrossing a 1973 Porsche, 911, then a 1985 Mustang 302 V8 which he still has.

We had our second 2023 **ESCA** Winter Go-Kart event February 28th with a great turnout of 13 drivers that included both members and guests! Unfortunately, due to the single run group limit of 12, we were split up and could not combine the top qualifiers from both groups for the final race. So, we ended up having two separate "mini" series for the night. Regardless, we all had a terrific time with smiles all around!

The format (with the exception of the two mini groups) was the same as last time with a 12 lap practice session, 12 lap qualifying and a 14 lap standing start final. Top time for both practice sessions went to Bryan Burnett with a 22.482. Qualifying for Group A, Blain Hendrix snagged Pole with a 22.191 and for Group B, Eric Lundy took Pole with a 22.214. Qualifying 2nd in Group A was yours truly at 22.380 and for Group B, Bryan Burnett at 22.284. Qualifying 3rd in Group A



was Gary Shannon at 22.437 and in Group B, Steve Rossiter at 22.338.

The final two races were intense both driving, and watching our fellow club members drive in the other group. The pictures tell the tale! Moving from 3^{rd} up to 1^{st} in Group A was Gary Shannon who was able to get past Blain and myself to hold the lead, nice driving Gary! I was able to keep 2^{nd} with Blain tailing me closely in 3^{rd} . $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ was Craig Hammond, Guy Southern and Alex Biddle. I was able to watch Group B and wow, it was a show! Eric Lundy was able to keep his 1^{st} place pole position for the win. Steve Rossiter was able to snag 2^{nd} AND set the fastest time for the night at 22.105 during the final. 
