Save the following Saturday night, **December 16th** for the **ANNUAL LIGHTS TOUR**, led by Lorie and Chuck Banks.





The cover car picture was Chuck Banks Pontiac Fiero, along with a Winter Karting Series article, an **ESCA** Club Charity Rallye, and a list of 8 new members, of which Lorie Banks and Bruce Sexauer are still members.

Inside was a column by the Chairman called Fast Times in which he talked about the club's September and October autocrosses, and the fact that we would now have a month to month contract with the airport from April to November because of construction that was going to happen at the site.

A full-page banquet flyer showed the event would be held at the Quail Inn in Oakmont.

There was a notice of the passing of **ESCA** Charter Member Dan Peterson.

A September autocross article called 2-day Autocross Part 1: MAD SAT by Josh Davies, talked about the rain, lots of rain and lack of drivers. The rain finally moved on and the results showed 43 drivers ran with Ace Robey taking TTOD in his BMWZ4, followed by Guy Southern and Bill Gemini.

A 2-Day Autocross Part 2: Beyond Sunderdome article also written by Josh Davies talked about the second day which had much better weather and the same track as Saturday but run in the reverse direction, with Top Time on street tires going to Alex Ivakhnenko in a Maita, with results showing 47 drivers and TTOD going to Mark Mervich Van Diemen RF90, followed by Guy Southern in his Corvette and Ace Robey in his BMW Z4.

An October autocross article called Southern Discomfort by Guy Southern talked but the nice fall weather and 75 drivers and 8 runs. TTOD went to Bill Gemini in his Stalker for the fourth time of the year.



The tour took us outside to view horseshoe cove and to areas where reconstructed whale skeletons hung about then out to the tide pool. Lastly back inside to view the areas where the studies take place.

The grandstands were mostly empty most days for practice of the F1 and support race of Can Am cars, so we sat were we wanted.


