

Winter Driving

My ancient brother came off the production line the year before the Mercedes W163 Formula 1 car. So, due to age, he recently decided to give up riding his BMW K bike. Then he got himself a used 2005 Mercedes SLK 350 that's more or less the twin to mine. Due some poor life choices he's now sentenced to life in Texas. He just sent me an email bragging:

Went for 150 mile cruise in east Texas behind the Pine Curtain. SLK was perfect as usual. 40 degrees-top down-heated seats, neck warmer, heater all on. A magical experience. and I responded:

Did that in Austria in January of 2005. Hard to believe that it was 19 years ago this month that we picked up the SLK at Sindelfingen.

At 28°f driving to Schwangau, Germany from the Inter-Alpen Hotel in Telfs-Buchen, Austria we were pretty comfy, top down. When we got to Schwangau we had yet another encounter with our Germanic heritage. Most everywhere we went in the SLK (with German plates) people spoke to us in German until they heard our accents. When we pulled up to the Parkplatz at Neuschwanstein the attendant came out of his booth and said: "Just park over there." As I was parking I asked Lilly if he'd said that in English. She thought maybe he had. I wondered why and she suggested I go ask him. So I wandered over and asked him.

He said: "Ia Natürlich."

I asked: "Warum?"

"Because you're American.... aren't you?"

"Yes, but how could you know that?"

"Who else would be so silly to drive with the top down in this weather?" I had to give him points for the logic and accuracy but deducted points for "German diplomacy."

Driving on the ice and snow was not too terrible but traction was often difficult to maintain. It was only later, after we got home, that I learned that if the polizei had accosted me, I could/would have been fined 2000 Euros for having the wrong tires. In Deutschland the fine was 'only' 400 Euros and I don't know what it was in Switzerland. But in order to bring the car into the US it had to have DOT approved tires and none of those would have been good enough for Austria in Winter.



We found that the bun warming seats and the 'air scarf' blowing warm air on our necks was probably more effective than the heater itself when the top was down.

BTW, when we drove up to the Inter-Alpen Hotel, it me flummoxed for a while when we approached, as there was no obvious place to park. Nothing around it but snow.

Huh what? Then when a few hundred meters away Lilly spotted the sign on a wall above something that looked like it might have been a loading dock.

Registration link will be in your email 10 days before the Autocross

Dues must be paid before you can register!

Site opens at 8:00 A.M.

Gate closes at 9:15 A. M.

All drivers must be 16 or older.

New Drivers Course walk at 9:15 A.M.

Registration closes at 9:30 A.M.

Mandatory Drivers Meeting at 9:40 A. M.

Self Tech Card must be completed, it is available at time of registration

Bring all release forms signed, they are emailed on Thursday before the autocross

At the Autocross – Remember:

Have Driver License & **ESCA** Card out before the gate. No Drugs or Alcohol allowed on site.

Bring contrasting colored tape for car number

Decibel limit is 95 – No car warm-ups before 10 A.M.

Helmets MUST be Snell Approved 2010 or newer

Must sign-up for Worker Position at Check-In

No food or water on site - please bring your own

If leaving early see Charley Sawyer or event chair

Drive slowly and quietly to and from site

A February calendar showed **ESCA** meeting at the West America Bank at the corner of Fulton and Guerneville in Santa Rosa.


