Make sure to have the volume Up (there are some subtle sounds) and the lights Out when watching!


(If little ones watch, there is only one bad word towards the end of the movie FYI). . . enjoy!

LONG AGO IN PIT STOP

April 1966

This five-page **PIT STOP** started off with an article entitled IN THE PITS by PIT STOP Committee Chairman Marsha Clowers, who talked about what a great job Autocross Chairman Chuck Smith did with the first large **ESCA** event of the year.

The other article on the front page entitled Coddingtown Autocross March 6, 1966, talked about the seven clubs invited to the event, and two others who had members attend. In all 61 drivers paid to run and the course was open for 6 ½ hours. Redwood SCC of Eureka and Sports Cars of Vallejo each sent 8 man teams, and it was estimated that there about 3000 spectators. On the Saturday night before the autocross there was an impromptu spaghetti party at Marsha Clowers home for our guests from Redwood SCC and Team Sprint and between 40 and 50 people attended and the party was still going at sunrise.

An On The Road (or under the CAR) article talked about twenty five brave people who met at the El Rancho and toured to Point Arena, lead by Ian Cook. Frank Jurin and Jon McNulty spent a lot of time under the hood of Ian's car trying to fix a stubborn fuel pump, and when the tour came to a stalled Austin Healy, everyone stopped to help. Highlights of the day were a tour of the lighthouse and Fort Ross, with lunch in Guerneville.

An article entitled SATELLITE GRAND PRIX V MARCH 27TH VACAVILLE, talked about breakfast at Dr. Arack's before a tour to a Lockheed autocross at Vaca Valley Raceway. It was a very high-speed event with speeds over 100 miles mph.

A PYLON PICKING article talked about 13 **ESCA** cars that went to Pleasanton to run in a Camino Corvettes event.

There was also March results from **ESCA**'s Coddingtown event with **ESCA**'s top 10 and number one was Loren Kistner in his MG Midget, the Camino Corvette event found Chuck Smith at the top of **ESCA** results and the Lockheed SCC found Gregg Wallace number one.

A full page calendar found Autocrosses, Rallies and Road Races listed on every Saturday and Sunday and one week found an **ESCA** regular meeting, Funkhana, Autocross, and Publicity meeting. Talk about busy.

Foothills Journey A TSD Road Rally Saturday, April 27, 2024



The rally starts in Roseville at the Brookfields Restaurant at 1817 Taylor Road and finishes at Round Table Pizza at 73 A Lincoln Boulevard in Lincoln.

The Foothills Journey Rally is designed to be fun for all with simple instructions and a scenic route traversing the foothills of the Sierra Nevada. The duration of the rally is approximately 4 hours. The Richta scoring and timing system will be used for the rally. Participants will need to download the FREE Richta Competitor app to their smart phone. Information about the Richta Competitor app is available at: richtarally.com. The General Instructions will be posted to MotorsportReg.

Registration 9 AM. First Car out at 10:01 AM. A competitor's meeting will be held at 9:30 AM. Awards will be given to first place in Novice, Senior, and Expert Classes.

Awards beyond first place in class dependent upon number of entries. This event is open to the public, all types of cars, not just Porsches.

The Foothills Journey Rally is the second of six TSD rallies to be presented by SVR in 2024. Year end Awards will be presented to the highest finishers in each class who have completed at least four of the six rallies.




