
Hello ESCAN's!

- ✓ Empty all loose items from your Car, Including the Trunk
- ✓ Remove wheel covers or Hub Caps
- ✓ Helmet must be Snell Approved 2010 or newer.
 - √ (Snell 2000 & 2005 are not allowed)
- ✓ Safety equipment is installed correctly and does not have any excess movement
- ✓ Seat Belts present & secure: Two-strap shoulder harnesses shall not be worn in open automobiles, which are not equipped with roll bars.
- ✓ Roll bars are REQUIRED in all purpose-built competition cars and any
- \checkmark other open cockpit AUTOMOBILES using racing (non-D.O.T. approved) tires
- ✓ Tight steering wheel
- ✓ Firm brake pedal
- ✓ No side-to-side Wheel bearing movement
- ✓ Lug Nuts all are present and tight
- ✓ Tires, have good tread depth with no bulges, cuts or cords
- ✓ Ensure the battery is properly tied down
- ✓ Engine and all other fluid caps are present and secure
- ✓ Engine hoses, wires, and belts are in good shape and free of cracks.

The Under 40 Club

"The event went well with a fun flowing course. A technical finish was make-or-break for each run." That was the report by co-chair Steve Rossiter. Our previous two events at the SR Fairgrounds had tight courses, and I wanted to see if we could fit a "bigger" course on our new little site.

I used the same 300' radius (60 MPH) as the big downhill sweeper at Factory Pipe and managed to fit it in there twice with a figure 8 arrangement with two crossovers. I got deep into third gear twenty times that day—what fun! Fully half of the course was at full throttle in my little Bug, and the V8s got to stretch their legs too.

Wide 30' gates allowed more choice of line and gave the

bigger cars some room to run. Wide gates require wide spacing between gates to avoid the dreaded "sea of cones" effect. But with the gates spaced approximately 100' apart, a lot of drivers had a tough time finding the next gate. One out of five runs was a DNF, which is way too many. I learned that in the future we need to use more pointer cones and/or mark the course with gypsum when using wide gates and spacing on a fast course.

After ten seconds of full throttle (in my car), guess what comes next: Heavy Braking (or occasionally Trailing Throttle

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Oversteer!). There were two braking points, the second one leading into heavily offset gates to slow everybody down for the finish. You really had to late-apex the last five gates, and it took all day to get close to the right line.

There's more to be done, as the dip was still too abrupt. We're still learning the ins and outs of the new site and we'll be able to have even more fun in the future.

Sir Isaac Newton predicted 39.5 seconds at .8Gs, so I named the course Under 40. In the end there were ten drivers who made it into the Under 40 Club: Tom Buggia got TTOD with 37.210 seconds. Congrats Tom! Next was Mike Cardozo, Jonathan Teeter, Rich Bishop, Steve Rossiter, Mike Prescott, Martin Franusich, Martin Johns, Alex Ivakhnenko, and Guy Southern. 



Sports Car Councils met for bragging rights and trophies on the fourth of July weekend. Steve Tucker was going from **ESCA** in his Volksvair. He also stated Leigh Miller was the new Autocross Chairman and wished him luck and reminded everyone we should all work together and have fun. There was also an article for the ladies and what to bring on a long weekend at the races.

An article entitled SNOOPY II by rallymaster Bob the Beard talked about **ESCA**'s May night rallye, which had the second biggest turn-out in SSCA history with 105 cars and 12 were club cars, and Alan Brandt and Charles Seeley took first overall. In one of the 12 club cars was Ian Cook in 8th place and the only one who is still an **ESCA** member.
