



Pit Stop in the Beginning July 1964 Volume II Issue V

This 2-page newsletter was a front page of articles and a second page that was a full-page calendar.

The front page articles included news that Marin GT was again putting on their slow speed autocross on July 4th at Hamilton Air Force Base with an entry fee of \$3.50 and the Napa Valley Checkpointers were putting on a rally starting from the Napa Bowl called the Lil Ole Winemakers Vintage '64 with an entry fee of \$2.00. Another article stated the new club in town C&D Touring Society had a rally and ESCA had won the club partitation trophy with a 9 car turn-out. Results from ESCA's Hare & Hound Time-Distance Rally showed Frank Demostene in his VW 1st, Bob Jenkins in his Volvo 2nd, Ron Nord in hisTR3 3rd, Dan Peterson in his Porsche 4th, Ian Cook in his MG Midget 5th, Bob Guyton Yamaha 6th, Frank Granada in his Porsche 7th and Don Eaton his TR4 in 8th. ESCA's Rally of the August Moon was set for August 19th starting from the Big "G" Supermarket in Sausalito, with finish at Pinky's Pizza Parlor in San Rafael.

For Sale was Jim Delapp's Lancia sedan, a recent third place winner in sedan class at the Cobb Mountain Hillclimb, with a discount price to **ESCA** members of \$752.00. A rumor was Martha Liske's Mini was for sale. FOR FREE listed the Mac Donald household had an over-abundance of kittens and they are wishing to find a good home for them.

On the second page calendar events listed were SCCA Races at Cotati Raceway, Autocross by Competition SCC, and NCCA, Rallyes by Sorry Safari, Redliners, El Dorado TC, Alpine TC, SFSCC, PCA, Modesto 99ers.

Printed below the calendar, readers were asked to look for more information in the S.F. Examiner, S.R. Press Democrat, and S.F. Chronicle.


