Here we are at the midpoint of 2026 — the perfect time to take a breath, look back at what we've accomplished, and get excited about everything still ahead. Clubs don't thrive by accident; they thrive because people show up, pitch in, and occasionally tolerate the smell of hot tires. Fortunately, the first half of this year has been full of proof that **ESCA** is thriving.

A Big Win: Insurance Secured

Let's start with the big one: **ESCA** officially locked down a new insurance policy through Safehold. This wasn't just paperwork — it was an endurance event worthy of its own trophy. Thanks to John and Craig keeping us aligned with safety expectations, we now have stable coverage that protects every run, rallye, and meeting going forward.

We also explored the idea of joining an LLC, which may lower upfront costs but could complicate events. That discussion is still ongoing, but for now, we're covered, confident, and ready to roll.

Communication Upgrades: Radios + Live Timing

We beefed up event communication with new FRS radios for the autocross trailer — a small improvement with a big impact. Smoother operations, clearer calls, and fewer "Wait... what did they say?" moments.

And live timing on the website? Total game changer. No more waiting for slips at the finish; now you can follow the action in real time, root for friends, or refresh obsessively to confirm your latest personal victory.

Autocross: Our Core, Our Community

Autocross remains one of **ESCA**'s strongest programs, and our backtoback events on July 26 and August 2 will be an excellent test of teamwork. Some of our seasoned course preppers can't make both events, which means this is a perfect chance for more members to step in.

Course design, setup, teardown, and operating positions often fall on a small crew — expanding that circle keeps things fun, fast, and sustainable. Showing up early, staying a little late, or learning a new role helps more than most people realize.

Club Business: Moving Forward

Several important organizational items are moving along:

- Constitution amendments and a dues review are nearly ready for active member vote.
- The Member at Large proposal will also go to the membership for decision.
- Entertainment and Rallye chair positions remain open — waiting for someone with ideas, energy, or simply the willingness to try something new.

Signs of a Healthy Club

ESCA is in great shape: consistent meetings, active programs, solid finances, and a steady stream of new members. Not perfect — just alive, evolving, and supported by people who genuinely care.

A Personal Note

ESCA has decades of history built by people who poured in time, energy, and creativity. Now we're at a moment where new hands and new voices can make a real, meaningful difference.

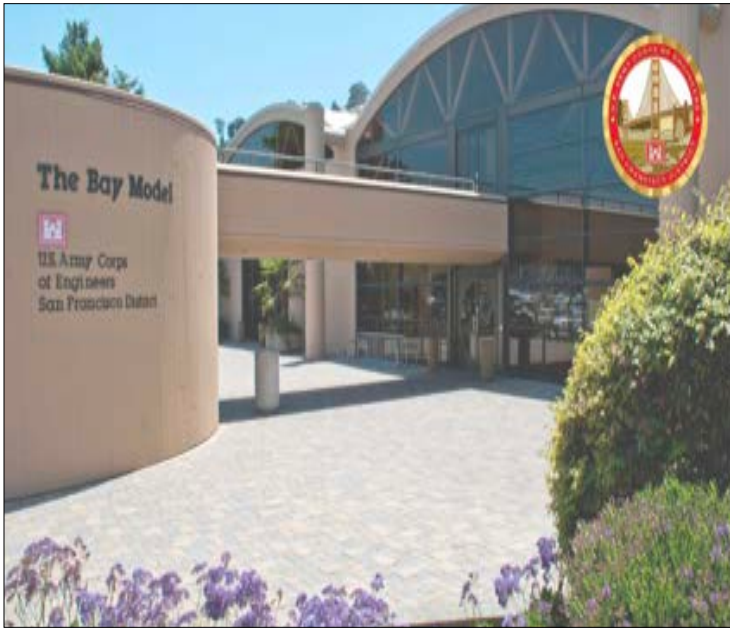

Bay Model Tour Wednesday, September 16, 2026

For those of you unfamiliar with the Bay Model in Sausalito it was built in 1957 by the Army Corps of Engineers as a fully operational hand sculpted scale bay model. Used for scientific research between 1958 and 2000 it is the only one of its kind in the world.

In a cavernous warehouse of approximately 2 acres it simulates the tides affecting the entire San Francisco Bay Area. A hydraulic working scale model of 1 foot per 1000 feet, it can study the currents, tidal action, sediment movement, and mixing of salt with fresh water. Depth variations are compensated by 250,000 copper strips.

A complete daily tide cycle is completed in 14.9 minutes.

We will start our tour at the Route 1 Bakery in Tomales, the bakery has great coffee and pastries.

Departing at 10:00am we will drive Highway 1 down into Point Reyes Station and on to Stinson Beach. This leg takes approximately one hour. At Stinson Beach there are restrooms available at the beach parking lot, also a well equipped market if you wish to order sandwiches and lunch for later.

From Stinson Beach we continue on Highway 1 into Mill Valley, a short hop on 101 and on to the Bay Model in Sausalito.

Total drive time is approximately 1 and 1/2 hours, depending on the length of our stops we should arrive at the model noonish.

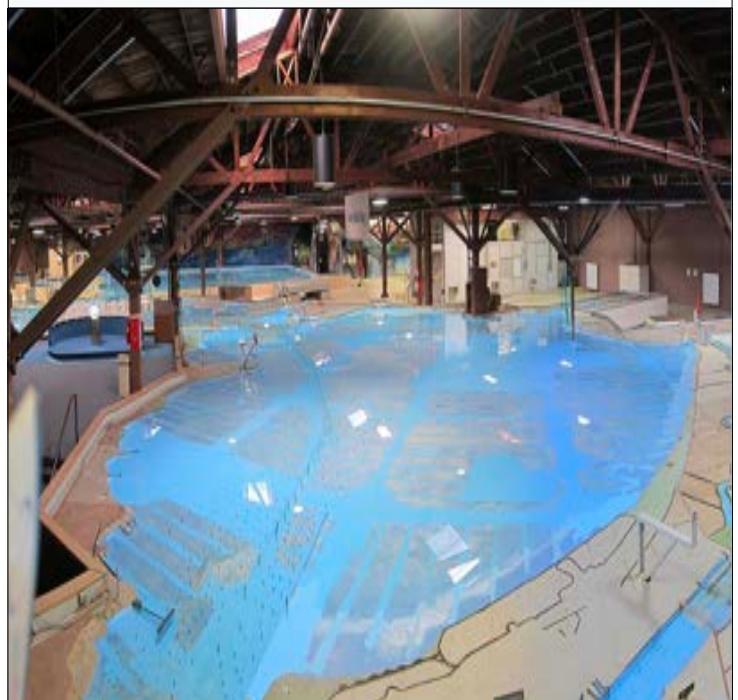
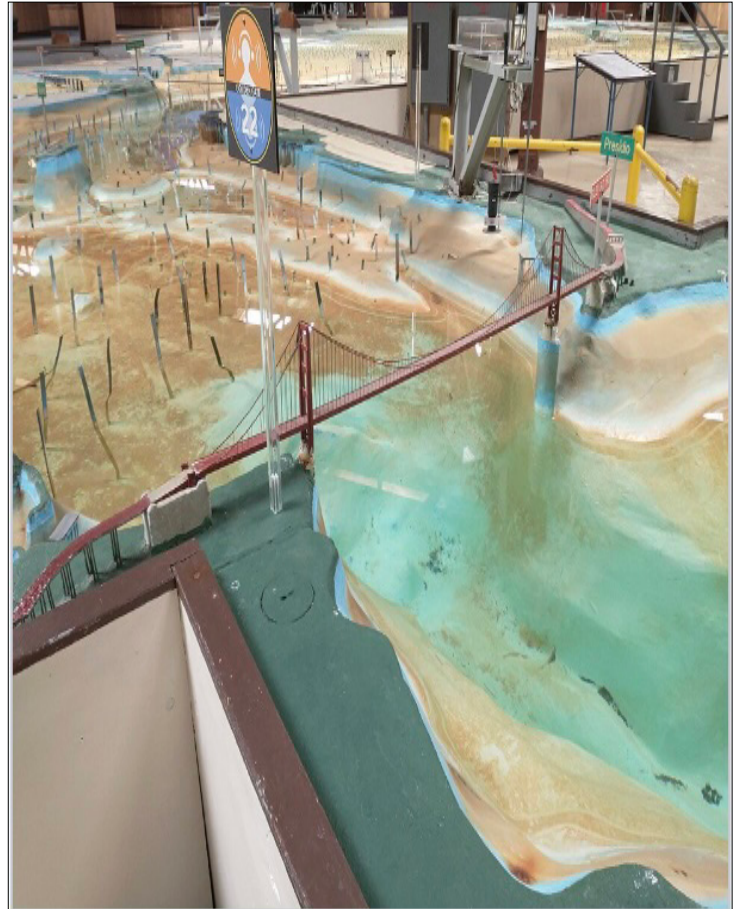
We have a scheduled Docent tour at 1:00pm so there is plenty of time for lunch, and pictures (you know Bob and his

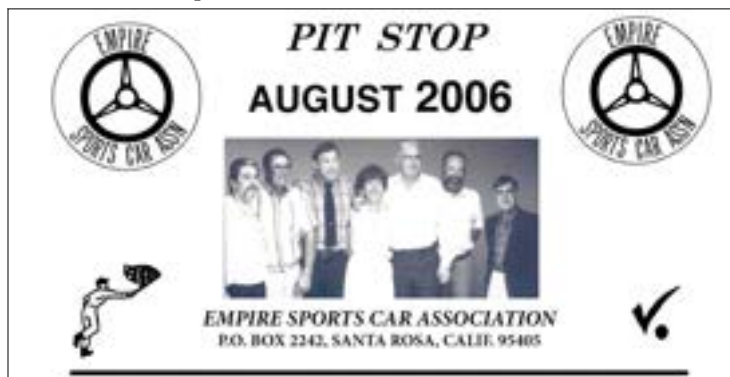
pictures) at several picnic tables bayside.
