For those of you unfamiliar with the Bay Model in Sausalito it was built in 1957 by the Army Corps of Engineers as a fully operational hand sculpted scale bay model. Used for scientific research between 1958 and 2000 it is the only one of its kind in the world.

In a cavernous warehouse of approximately 2 acres it simulates the tides affecting the entire San Francisco Bay Area. A hydraulic working scale model of 1 foot per 1000 feet, it can study the currents, tidal action, sediment movement, and mixing of salt with fresh water. Depth variations are compensated by 250,000 copper strips.

A complete daily tide cycle is completed in 14.9 minutes.

We will start our tour at the Route 1 Bakery in Tomales, the bakery has great coffee and pastries.

Departing at 10:00 AM we will drive Highway 1 down into Point Reyes Station and on to Stinson Beach. This leg takes approximately one hour. At Stinson Beach there are restrooms available at the beach parking lot, also a well equipped market if you wish to order sandwiches and lunch for later.

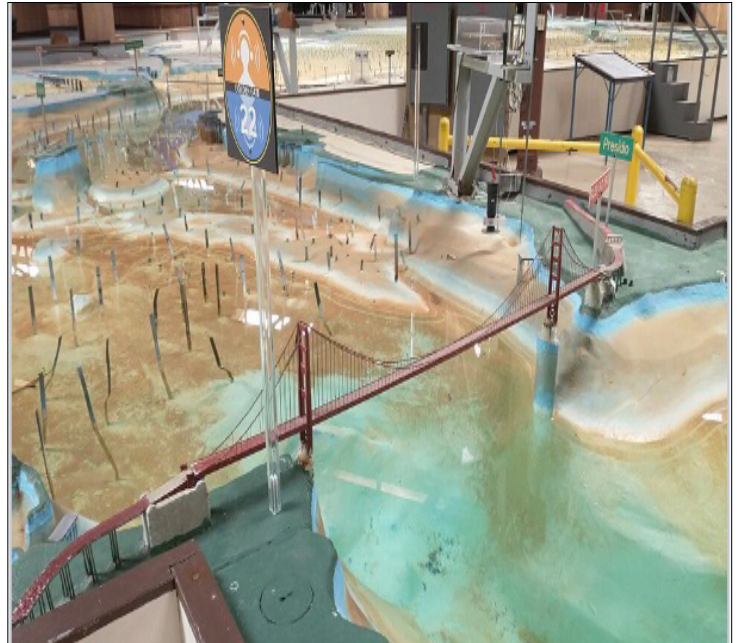
From Stinson Beach we continue on Highway 1 into Mill Valley, a short hop on 101 and on to the Bay Model in Sausalito.

Total drive time is approximately 1 and 1/2 hours, depending on the length of our stops we should arrive at the model noonish.

We have a scheduled Docent tour at 1:00 PM so there is plenty of time for lunch, and pictures (you know Bob and his pictures) at several picnic tables bayside.

The tour is free but always donations are welcome.

The tour can accommodate up to 20 people so please contact me to be included, the drive is spectacular and the tour very educational.

ESCA Constitutional By-Laws Update for Board Position

We would like to present a change to the **ESCA** Constitution. This was initiated by the idea to change our board member position of "Ex-Officio" to become "Member at Large". This would make the position easier to qualify for by eliminating the requirement that the board member needs to have been a prior **ESCA** officer, allowing more members to become involved. The duties would remain essentially the same, including acting in an advisory role. Requirements would be similar to other board members with the additional requirement that the member at large be an active* member for one year.

Below are the pertinent sections of the Constitutional By-Laws of the Empire Sports Car Association "**ESCA**" and the Policies and Procedures as they now read and with the proposed changes.

CONSTITUTIONAL BY-LAWS OF THE EMPIRE SPORTS CAR ASSOCIATION "ESCA"

Amended 2-6-2025 Amended XXXX 2026

ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS

Section 1. Board of Directors: The Board of Directors shall consist of the elected offices. The elected officers of this association shall consist of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and ~~Ex-Officio~~ *Member at Large*. They shall be responsible for the administrative affairs of the association. They shall have the general charge of the funds and of all property of the association. They shall have the power to order the payment of all bills or claims against the association, to execute the contracts and to transact all the usual business of the association.

Section 2. Paragraph E - "Ex-Officio": The ~~Ex-Officio~~: *Member at Large*:

- ❖ ~~shall have been an officer of the Board of Directors within the last four years.~~ *Shall have been an active member for a minimum of one year.*
- ❖ shall serve in an advisory capacity on the ~~newly elected~~ board.
- ❖ shall be nominated and elected in the same manner as new officers.

Sports Car Council. There were minutes from the November 19th meeting, where the Treasurer reported a balance of \$166.65 and John Monacelli, Kathy Kateley, and Chuck & Jean Sims were welcomed as new members. The club incorporation papers were voted on and signed. Martha Liske was thanked for making **ESCA** banners to be used on club tours. An "On the Road" article (Part 2) talked about Autocross; Trails; Funkhanas and Gymkhanas. An article entitled "**ESCA** Visits Marin" talked about a 10 car tour which covered 130 miles and took 8 hours. "Boo" was the title of an article about the **ESCA** Halloween Rallye that left from the G.K. Hardts car dealership on Santa Rosa Avenue, and found a Vampire and Dracula at Molino's corner, pirates in Occidental, birds in Bodega, ghosts in Bloomfield and Lions on Gravenstein Hwy. The rallye had 25 car run and finished back a G.K Hardt for a buffet and dance.
